Both libraries use the same **OSU Search** (basic and advanced) as library catalog and mega search engine.

- How to use the Tulsa (or the Stillwater) library catalog
- Emphasis on finding electronic books online (available 24/7 via Okey account)
- Ask A Librarian – online support

- Video tutorial uses a business database to demonstrate research steps
- Searching, revising search, identifying additional search terms
- Pre-selecting articles to a Folder for email, download, and export

- Using links to full text in other library databases and resource platforms

- Creating a bibliography in APA or MLA style

- Google Scholar is a very efficient search platform when looking for specific known citations and articles.
- It is Not a good browsing search engine (at the start of a research project).
- Google Scholar (Databases A – Z list) also links citations to available full text in OSU's resources and public domain sites.

#### 6. [Improving Search Results Using a Database Thesaurus or Subject List](#)

(for article searches in ERIC education, PsycINFO psychology, and business databases)

- Identify better search terms in the Subject listings below article citations
- The database Thesaurus suggests 'Online Education' instead of 'online learning'
- Find useful synonyms

Example "beverages": the Subject list shows over 30 types of beverages (alcoholic beverages, carbonated beverages, coffee drinks, non-alcoholic beverages, fermented beverages, etc.) in addition to a dozen 'Related Terms'
